



Contest Rules:

- **Eligibility:** Contest is only open to children up to the age of 18 residing in Berrien, Cass, Elkhart, LaPorte or St Joseph counties. Minors must receive prior permission from their parent or legal guardian. **All entries MUST be accompanied by an entry form signed by the child's parent or legal guardian – any submissions without an entry form will not be considered. Group submissions must have an entry form, signed by the parent or guardian of all group members, attached to main entry form.**
- **How to Enter:** Entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on April 2, 2010. Entries should be mailed to Prevent Child Abuse St Joe County, P.O. Box 6535, South Bend, IN 46660.
- **Judging and Selection of Winners:** All entries will be judged based on the following criteria: 1) artistic merit, 2) creativity and 3) theme communication. AMP may, at its discretion, designate judges for each contest or promotion. In the absence of a specific judge named for any contest or promotion, then in that case the Program Director or Station Manager of AMP will serve as contest judge. These contest judges will determine the winner(s) in all contests and promotions. All decisions made by the designated judges are final. By participating, contestants agree to be bound by all contest rules and the decisions of the judges.
- **Prizes:** The winner of the contest will have their logo featured on all RoofSit promotional materials, receive a copy of a t-shirt utilizing their logo and will be interviewed during RoofSit 2010 about the motivation for their submission.
- **Media Activity:** By participating in the contest, the participants and their legal guardians grant U93 permission to use, copy, modify and make available the submission to the public (with or without author attribution) for any purpose. The winning design will become the property of Artistic Media Partners to be utilized for marketing efforts as determined fit.
- **No recourse to Judicial or Other Procedures:** To the extent permitted by law, the rights to litigate, to seek injunctive relief or to any other recourse to judicial or any other procedure in case of disputes or claims resulting from or in connection with this contest are hereby excluded, and participants expressly waive any and all such rights.
